






This Shows a 6% Decrease in Student Proficiencies in 3 Years, Math Scores decreased 9%






Comparison of PUSD and Charter Basis During the Same School Year









Comparison of PUSD and Charter Basis During the Same School Year



Percentage of Students Who Met or Exceeded State Standards (AIMS) Fiscal Year 2010











PUSD Student Count 2006 to 2022


Growth in Administrative Staff, Principals, Teachers, and Students in Public Schools (% Change Since 2000)
