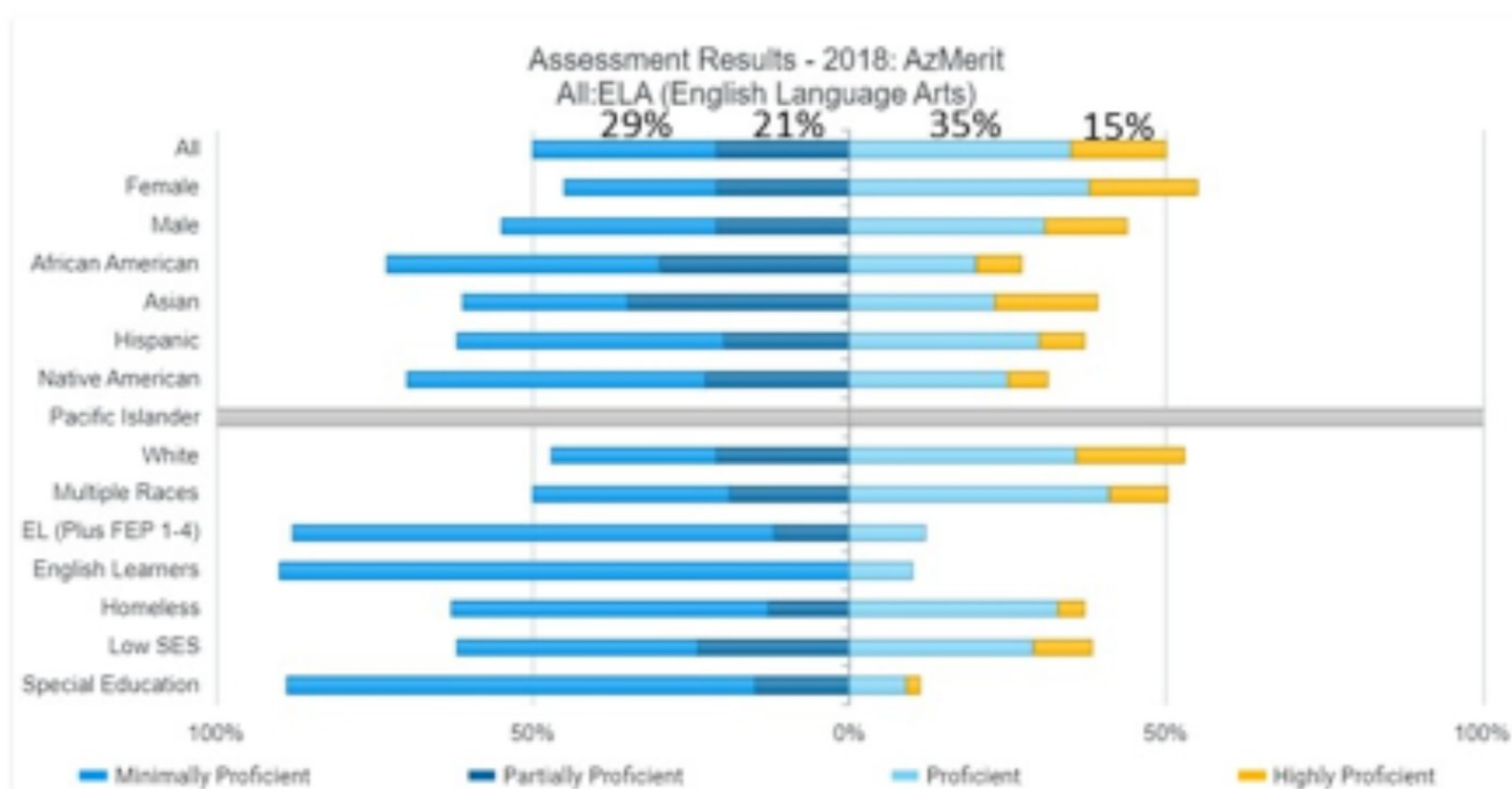

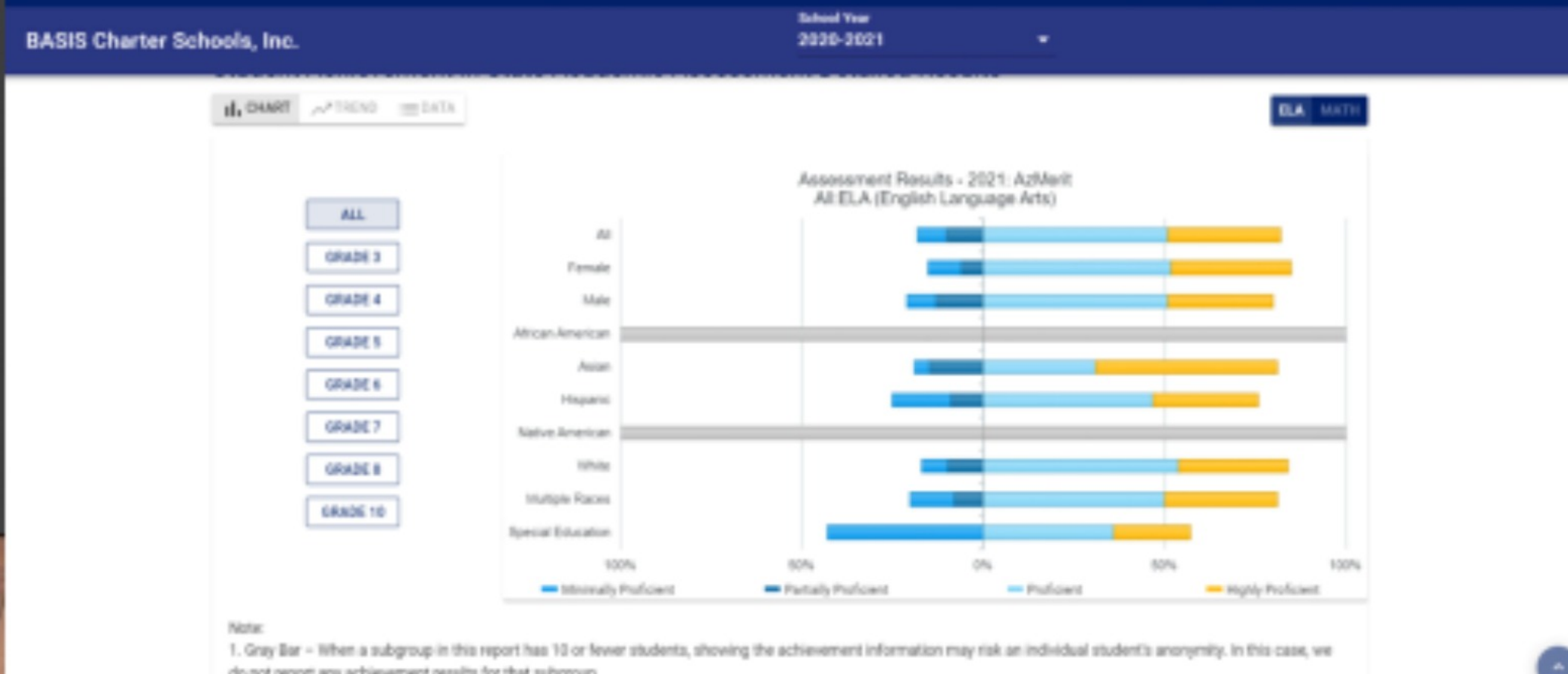

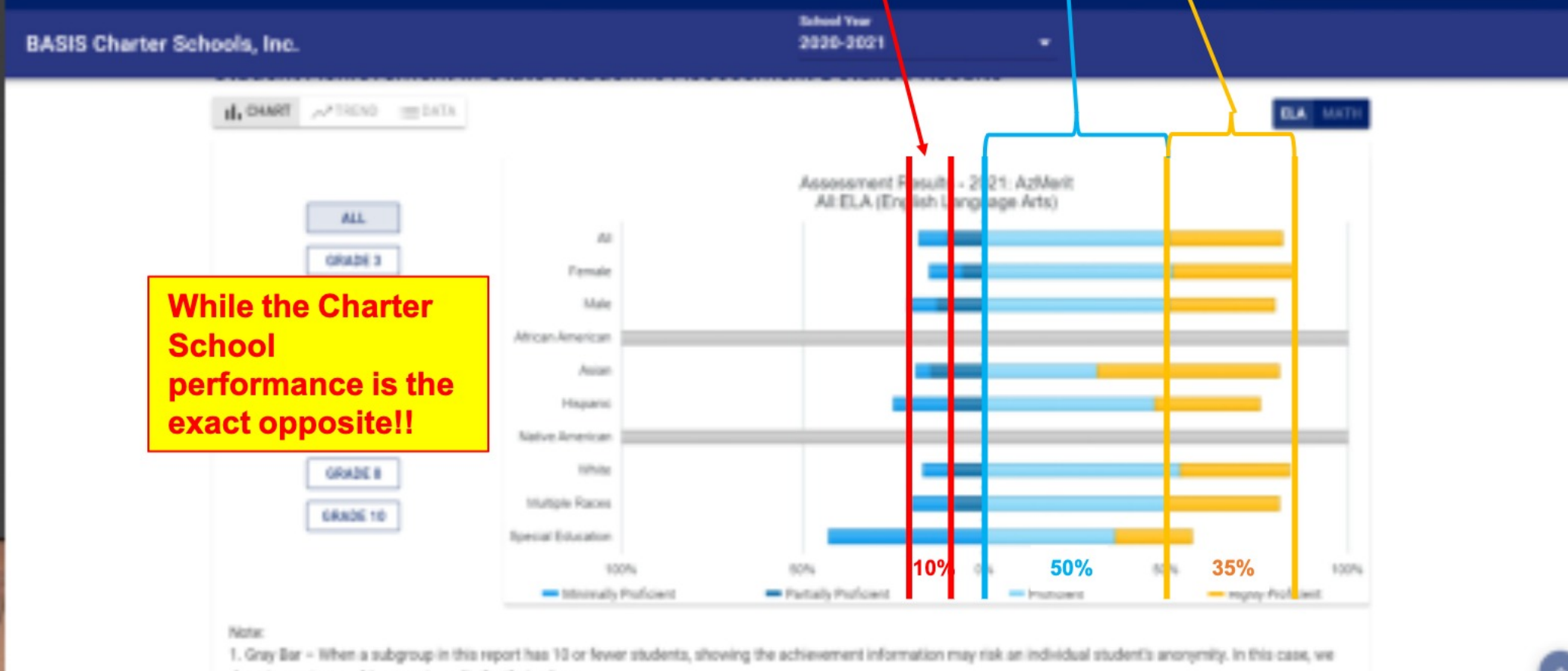
# Comparison of PUSD and Charter Basis During the Same School Year



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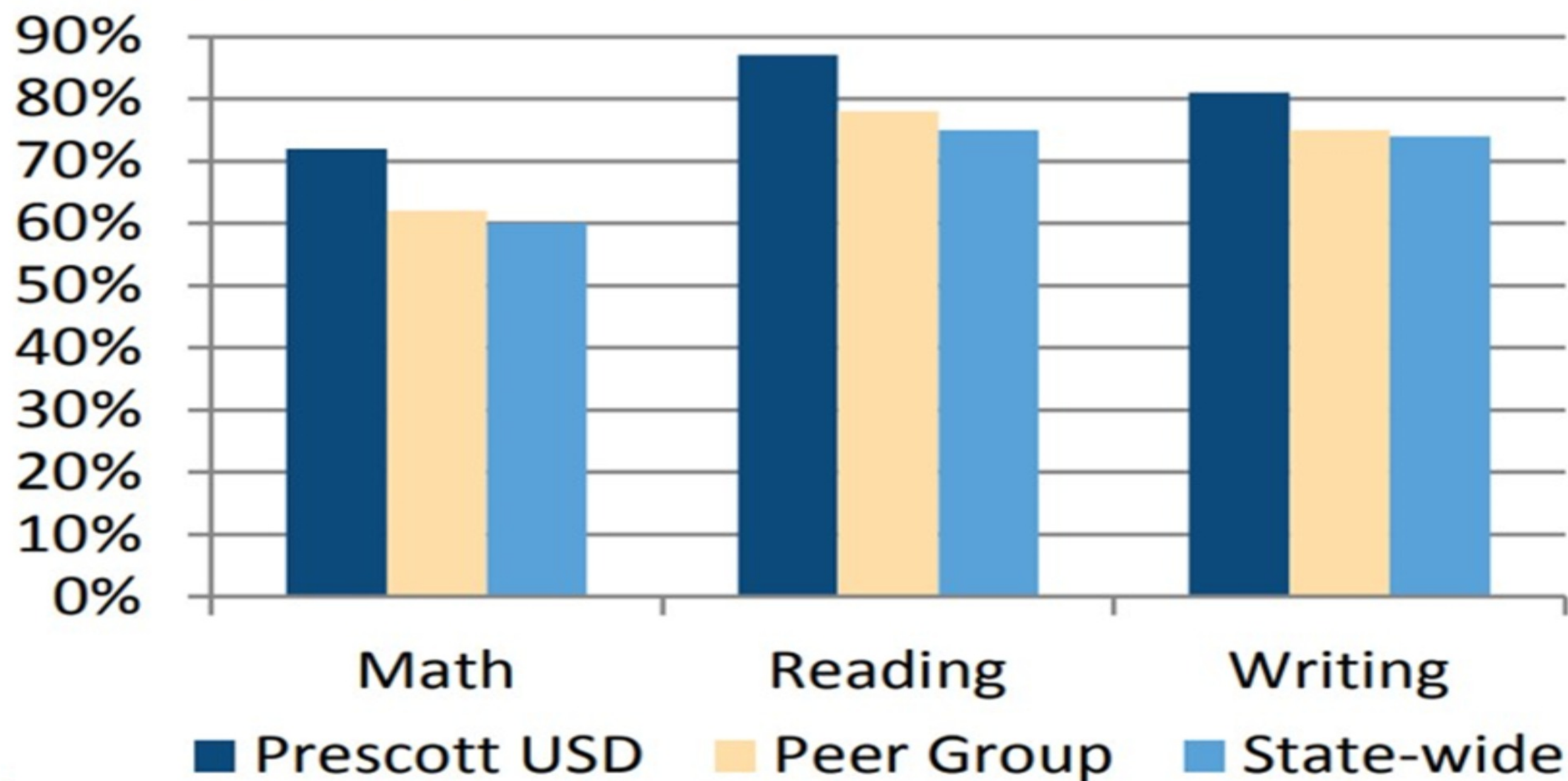


**Half of the current student population is Minimally Proficient!!**

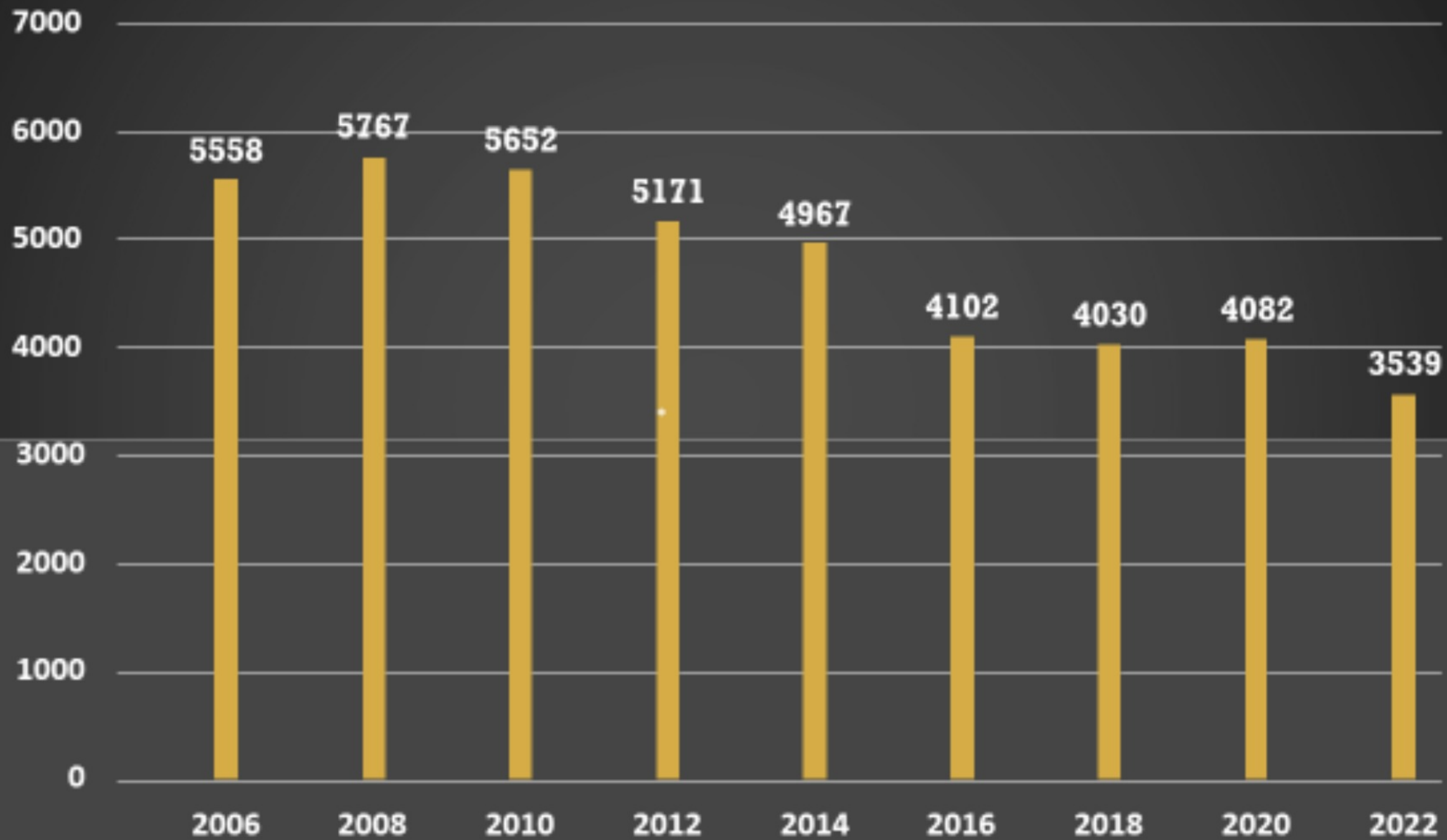

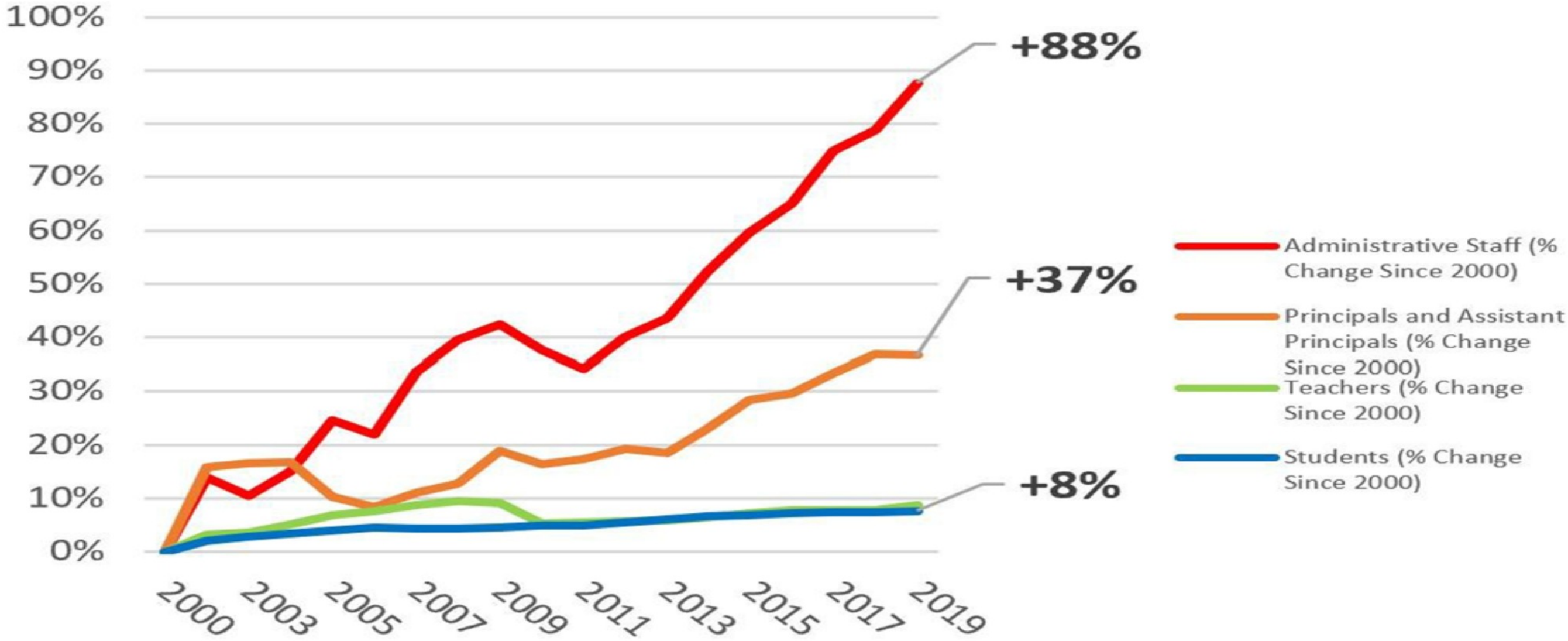
# PUSD Student Count 2006 to 2022

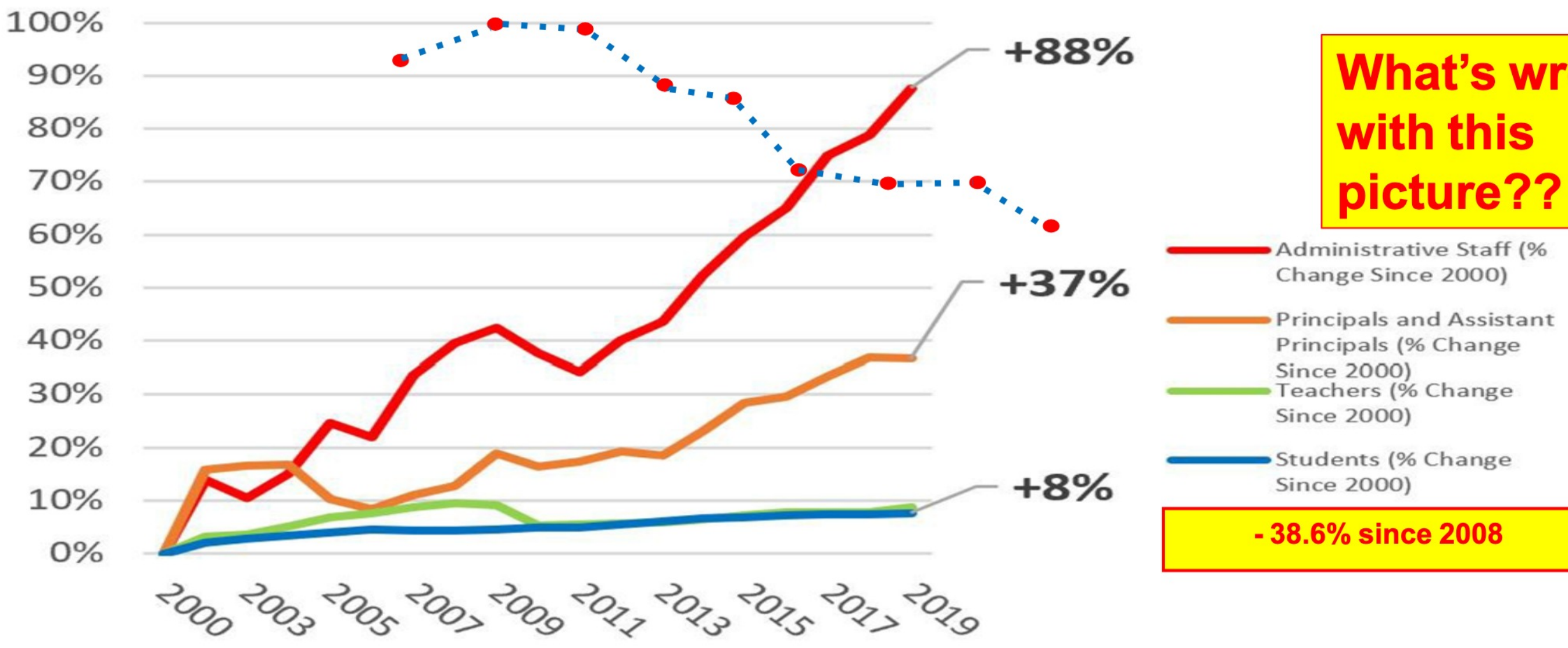
## Growth in Administrative Staff, Principals, Teachers, and Students in Public Schools (% Change Since 2000)
